Why the EXTRA MILE is different from other fundraising events?

Julia's House are very aware that Scout Groups also need to raise funds for valuable equipment and resources and this is why the Extra Mile gives a 50/50 split for all funds raised. 50% of sponsorship to your Group/Section and 50% to Julia's House.

What do the Young People get for their efforts? (*Money for their Group/Section + a fun day!*)

Your Groups/Sections will be given sponsorship forms. Each participant will receive an 'Extra Mile' medal showing the year participated, along with a trophy for the Section that raises the most. The top three individual fundraisers will also receive a goodie bag from Julia's House that will include an Extra Mile T-shirt.

Where is the EXTRA MILE being held?

At Buddens Scout Centre. All Adults will need to sign in and out with their YPs. The run route will be marked out. Areas will be marked off and manned to help organise rotas for the runs with designated areas for YPs to be collected and dropped off before and after each race. A picnic area will be allocated which will house hot food vans and other refreshments.

What do the Leaders have to do? (*apart from run in the Leader's Mile!*)

Dorset Scouts County Office, in liaison with Julia's House, will provide Leaders with sponsorship forms, posters, letters for parents/carers, itinerary of the day and a kit list. Leaders are asked to help support their YPs to get in involved. Keep County Office updated and we will post news on how well Groups are doing with their sponsorships, keep them encouraged! We ask that on the day 2 Leaders/Adult Helpers can be in attendance to help escort their YPs to the start line and release them from the mile at the end! Leaders will need to supply County Office with Sponsorship forms & money raised for financial settlement between both charities.

What about Parents/Carers?

Families are welcome! Parents/carers must make sure their YPs are allocated to their Leader in time for their Section race. Then sit back and enjoy the day.

Do you need any Volunteers for the day?
